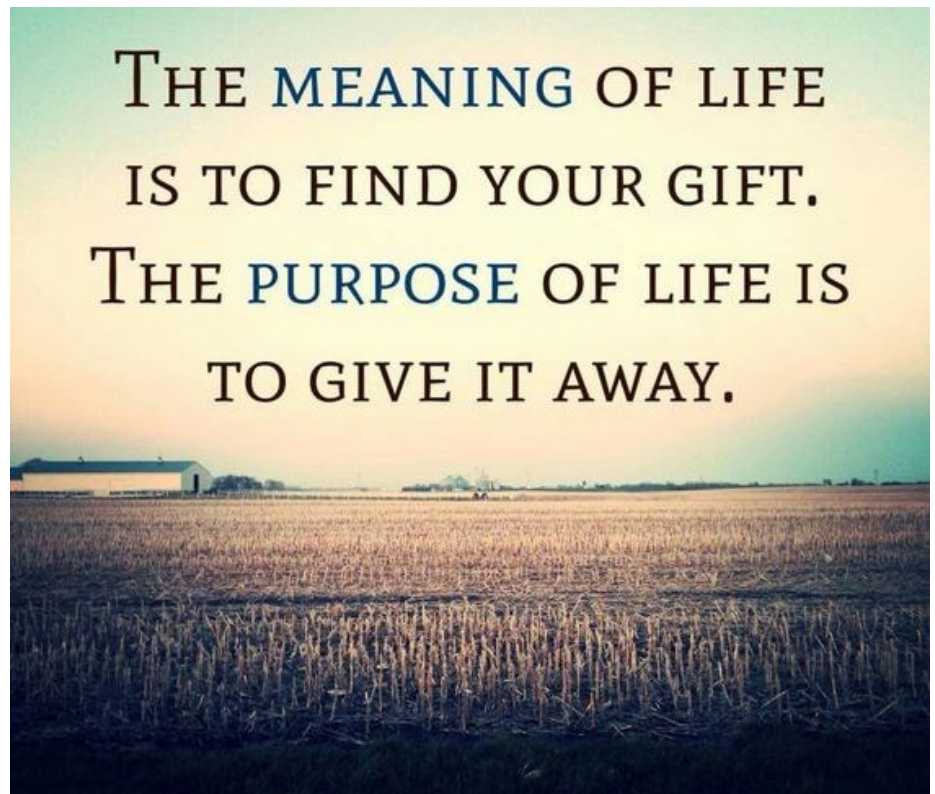

SWING INTO SPRING!

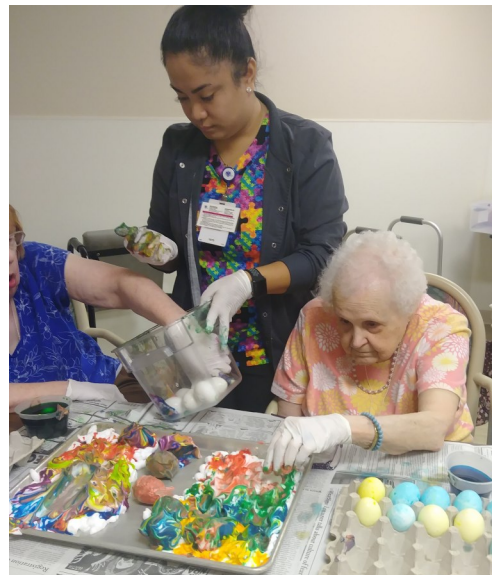
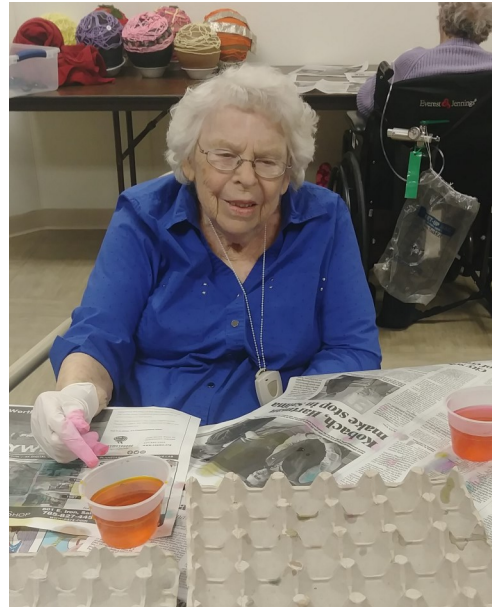
Lots of changes and excitement as the grass turns green and the sunshine beams! During February and March we were busy little bees. Check out all the fun and see what is in store for April at PSLC.
