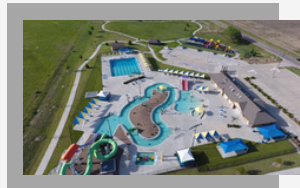
COLBY EVENT CENTER

The Aquatic Park consists of a 7,838 sq. ft. leisure pool with a lazy river, zero depth entry, floatable walk area, family slide, speed slide, flume slide and water slide splash down area. There is

a separate 4,844 sq. ft. 8 lane competition lap pool with a 1 meter and a 3 meter diving board.
